

Rev. Daniel J. Marek

The Rev. Daniel J. Marek, 80, of Taylor, Texas, passed away Tuesday, May 25, 2004, at his residence.

The Rev. Marek was born June 9, 1923, in Snook, the son of John and Mary Sebesta Marek. He was a resident of Taylor, a retired minister with the Unity of the Brethren Church and a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps, serving during World War II. The Rev. Marek was a former president of Unity of the Brethren Synodical Committee, past president of the Taylor Kiwanis Club and past president of the Taylor Ministerial Alliance.

On Aug. 25, 1949, he married Marie Whitten, who survives him. Other survivors include his sons, John Steven Marek and wife Janet of Austin, David Jonathan Marek of Spring and James Andrew Marek and wife Susan of Taylor; five grandchildren, Matt, Mandi, Kayla, Rachel and Kelsey; and one brother, Julius Luksa of Rosenberg.

The Rev. Marek was preceded in death by his parents, one infant daughter, three brothers and one sister.
